Avian influenza has become a threat to human and animal health and the general economy of many countries, the U.S. and the Delmarva region. This presentation will focus on the natural ecology of avian influenza in wild migratory birds. The presentation will also review past and current avian influenza surveillance and poultry emergency response efforts in the Delmarva peninsula region which produced 567 million broiler chickens at a value of \$1.6 billion in 2006.
